

**MINUTES - SPECIAL MEETING  
BOONE TOWN COUNCIL  
AUGUST 30, 2011**

A special meeting of the Boone Town Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of the Green Valley Elementary School. Mayor Loretta Clawson presided. Council members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lynne Mason, Andy Ball, Rennie Brantz, Jamie Leigh and Stephen Phillips. Town Attorney Sam Furgiuele was also present.
