

**MINUTES-SPECIAL MEETING  
BOONE TOWN COUNCIL  
SEPTEMBER 15, 2011**

A special meeting of the Boone Town Council was called to order at 7:09 p.m., Thursday, September 15, 2011, in the Council Chambers, 1500 Blowing Rock Road. Mayor Loretta Clawson presided. Council members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lynne Mason, Jamie Leigh, Rennie Brantz, Andy Ball, and Stephen Phillips (arrived at 7:26 p.m.) Staff members in attendance were Town Manager Greg Young, Deputy Clerk Kim Brown, Police Captain Jim Wilson, Police Lieutenant Danny Houck, and Downtown Development Coordinator Pilar Fotta. Town Attorney Sam Furgiuele was also in attendance.

The purpose of the meeting was to conduct a work session on the proposed noise ordinance.

Council invited comments and concerns from various members of the business community and residents including the following: Mark Dickson-Galileo's Café & Bar, Jesse Kellogg-Revolution's Hookah Lounge, Terry Taylor and Judy Humphrey-residents of Grand Boulevard, Skip Sinanian and Matt Johnson-Boone Saloon, Brad Harmon-Harmon's Dixie Pride and resident of King Street, Tommy Lee-Nth Degree Gallery & Studios, Cameron Carswell-ASU Student Government Association, Brad Farrington-ASU Wesley Foundation and resident of Grand Boulevard neighborhood, David Johnson-member of public, Lauren Estes-ASU Student Government President, Boone Police Lieutenant Danny Houck, and Boone Downtown Development Coordinator Pilar Fotta. After lengthy discussion of the proposed noise ordinance and the concerns and issues presented by members of the Town Council, Town Staff, business community, and residents, Council directed Town Attorney Sam Furgiuele to revise the proposed noise ordinance to reflect the changes and concerns contained in the discussion. It was the consensus of the Council to add to the next regular meeting agenda, an action to schedule another special meeting in order to review the revised noise ordinance.

Upon a motion by Council Member Mason, seconded by Council Member Ball, Council adjourned the meeting at 10:43 p.m.
