



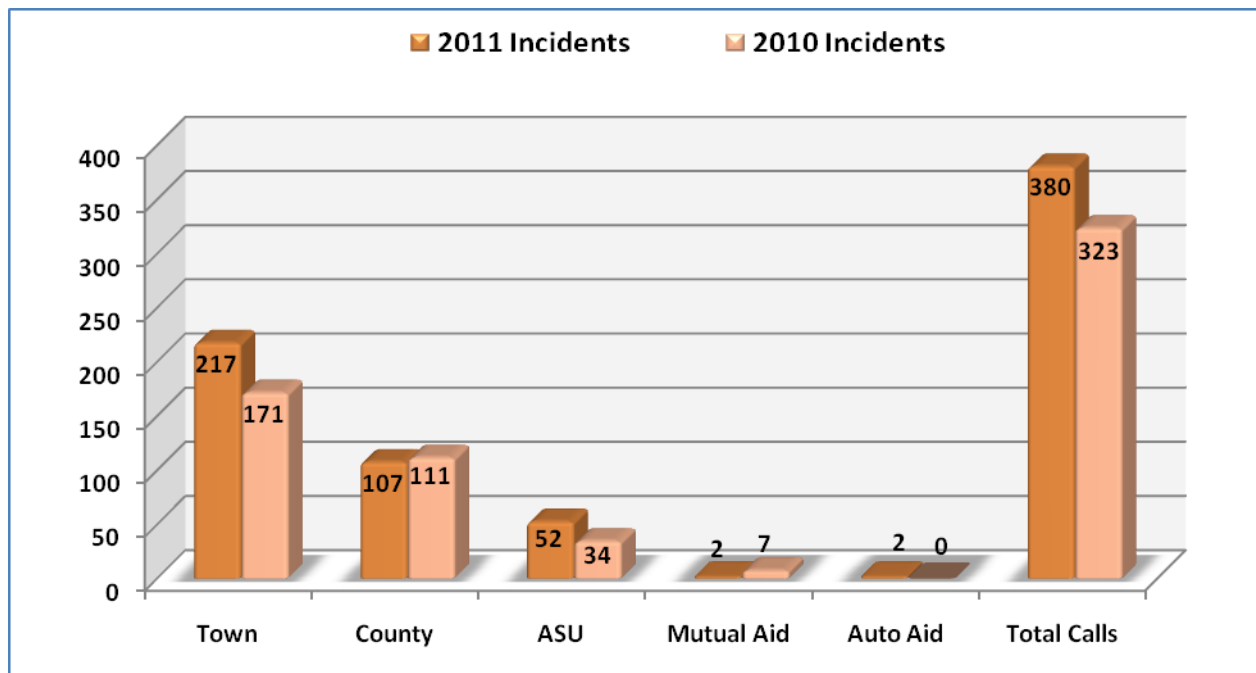

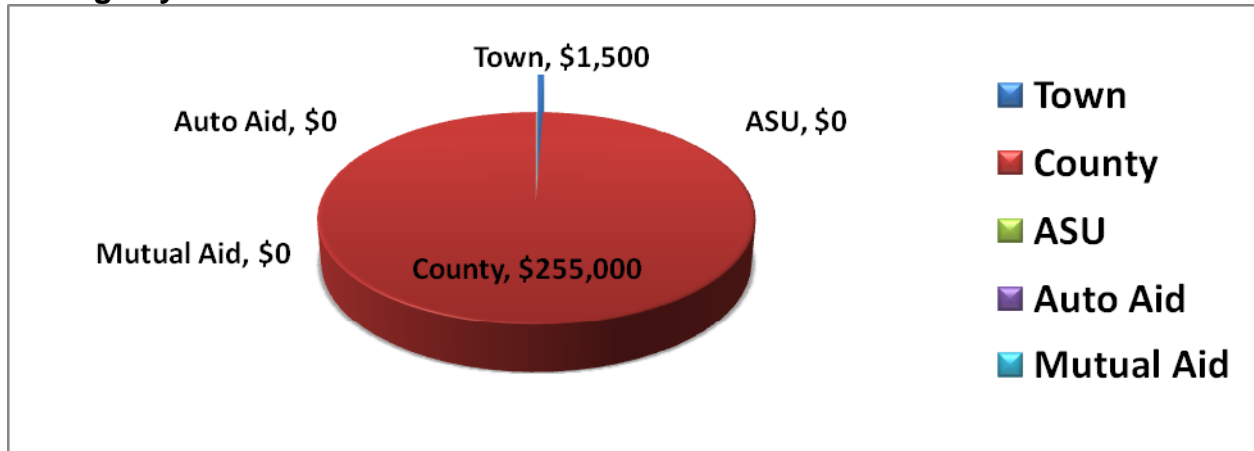
INCIDENT INFORMATION

During the second quarter of 2011, Boone Fire Department responded to 380 incidents. The average response times for emergency and routine incidents were 4.4 minutes within town limits and 9.9 minutes within the rural fire service district.

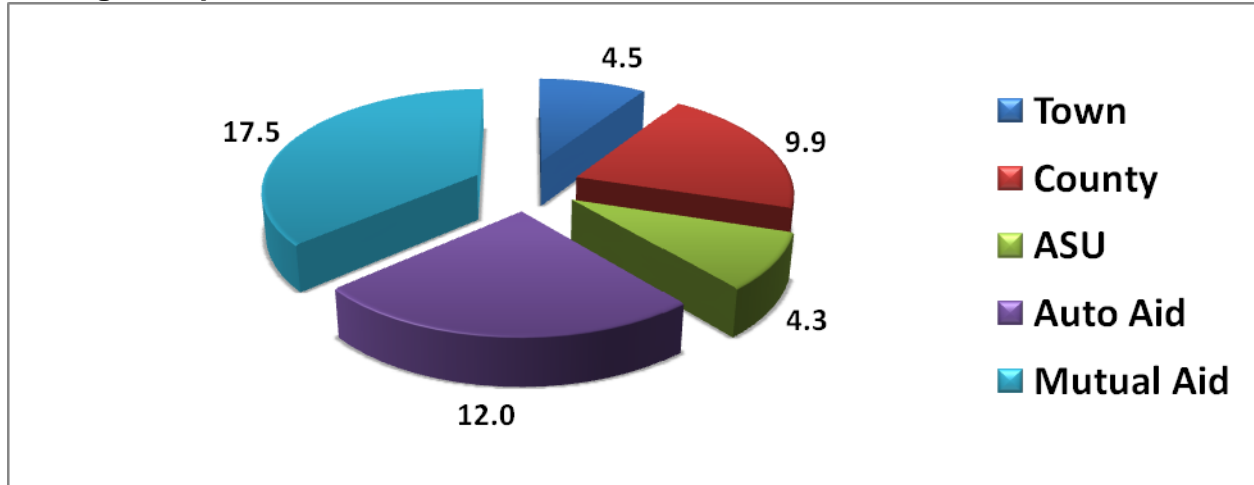
Number of Incidents by Jurisdiction



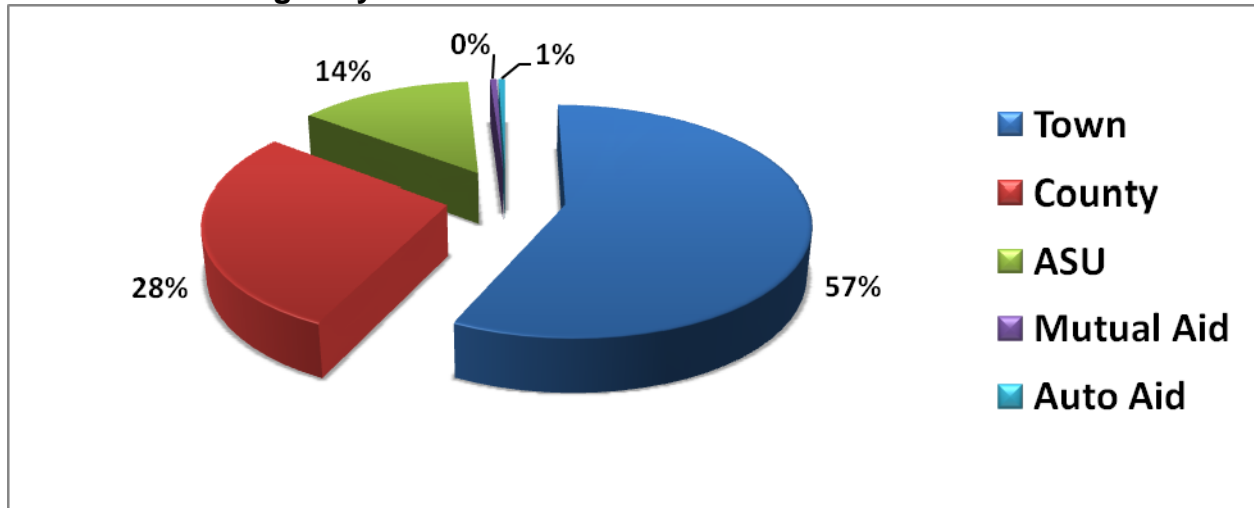
Damage by Jurisdiction

PERSONNEL

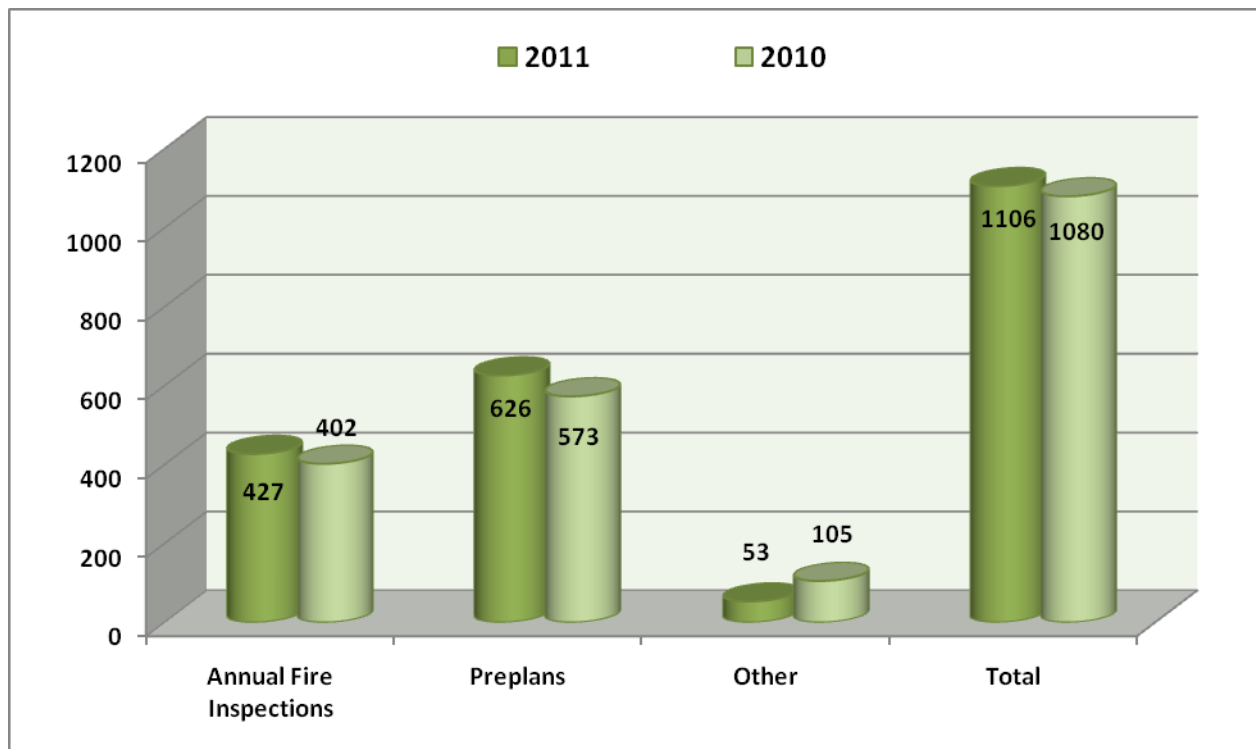
At the present time the Boone Fire Department is running a roster of 17 permanent and 14 volunteers for a total of 31 members.
